Drug Affected: IV Dobutamine

Dear Providers,

Currently, there is a nationwide shortage of dobutamine due to manufacturing delays and/or increased demand. At OLOLRMC, we have a very limited stock, and no new supply will be available for a while (pending availability from manufacturers).

Dobutamine is one of the inotropes with indication for patient requiring inotropic support. To address the dobutamine shortage, Pharmacy has provided the following recommendations for an alternative agent.

Recommendations Summary for Dobutamine alternative during the period of shortage

 If current supply of dobutamine is exhausted; <u>Milrinone</u> will be a therapeutic alternative.

Dobutamine	Route of	Unit Restrictions	Clinical Consideration
Alternative	administration		
Milrinone	Intravenous (IV)	Critical units Progressive care units Cardiac Telemetry units – must be monitored, no titrations	<u>Caution in renal impairment</u> : will require a lower dosing regimen in the setting of renal impairment
