Drug Affected: Penicillin G benzathine (Bicillin LA) and penicillin G benzathine & G procaine (Bicillin CR)

Dear Providers,

Currently, there is a nationwide shortage of penicillin G benzathine and penicillin G benzathine/procaine due to an increase in demand combined with only having one supplier. At OLOLRMC, we have a very limited stock, and the estimated recovery date from the manufacturer is 2024.

Penicillin G benzathine is the drug of choice for syphilis. Other common indications for use include the treatment of pharyngitis. Penicillin G benzathine and G procaine is not commonly used in adults.

Please consider these alternative options for adults while penicillin G benzathine is on shortage:

	Penicillin G benzathine (Bicillin LA)
Recommendation	Reserve for syphilis
with limited stock	Pharyngitis alternative of amoxicillin of cephalexin for 10 days
Recommendation with no available stock	 Reserve remaining for confirmed syphilis in pregnant patients Consider an ID consult if no penicillin G benzathine is available to treat syphilis in patients with HIV or who are pregnant Alternative syphilis treatment: Early syphilis: doxycycline 100 mg PO BID for two weeks Late/Latent/Unknown duration: doxycycline 100 mg PO BID for four weeks Pharyngitis alternative of amoxicillin 500 mg PO BID or cephalexin 500 mg PO BID for 10 days
